Instructions for writing a summary

The text of the abstract should contain a minimum of 200 and a maximum of 300 words, not including the title, name(s) of the author, affiliation information and keywords. It should be written in Times New Roman font, size 12, paragraph 1.5, with both sides aligned. The abstract should contain the full name and surname of all authors and the name and surname of the mentor (assistant professor, full or part-time professor) who helps in the process of preparing the paper, and should not contain literature, tables and diagrams. At the end of the abstract, a minimum of 3 key words that summarize the meaning of the work should be written in Italic font, size 10. Furthermore, the text of the abstract should contain an introduction, objective, methods and results (if it is a research paper) and a conclusion. For ease of understanding, the text must be written in Latin in English and in one of the languages of the region (the author's native language). The oral presentation should last from 12 to 15 minutes and can be prepared in the form of ppt or Prezi presentation. The program committee will review all submitted papers and will send the authors a confirmation of acceptance or rejection as soon as possible.

Instructions for poster presentation

The size of the poster presentation can be a minimum of 80x60 cm and a maximum of 120x90 cm. The authors of the poster presentations will have a special room for the presentation of their works, and they will be provided with funds for setting up the posters. The text on the poster presentation must be written in Latin.
