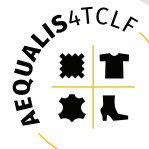

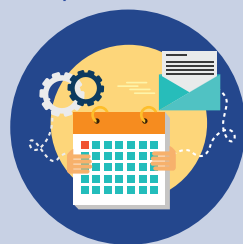

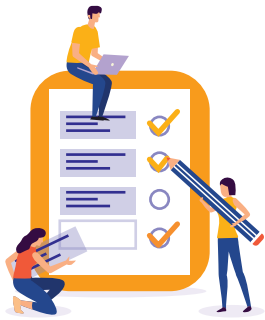
## REGISTRATION FEE

### Trip to Ovčar Banja

Sunday, 20 September 2026 (11:00-14:00)



Ovčar Banja is located 17 km from Čačak in an area of exceptional natural beauty. It lies within the Ovčar–Kablar Gorge, a narrow section of the West Morava River valley. Ten medieval monasteries, often referred to as the “Serbian Mount Athos,” are situated within a small area of the gorge. Visitors can explore the rich cultural and historical heritage of the region and admire the monasteries of Nikolje, Preobraženje and Blagoveštenje, as well as others located on the slopes of Mount Ovčar (985 m) and Mount Kablar (885 m). In the centre of Ovčar Banja, surrounded by picturesque scenery, there is a Nature Centre featuring an exhibition of species native to the gorge.
